

## Meru Climbing Itinerary

### 3 Days & 2 Nights



Day	Destination	Description	Accommodation
1	Miriakamba Hut 2500 m	<p><b>“Climbing a cone volcanic and enjoys a panoramic ascent”</b></p> <p>Breakfast served at Mai Kilimanjaro Home stay.</p> <p>Please pack bags prior to breakfast, check out, and place valuables in the farm house safe.</p> <p>Transfer and Registration in the office at Arusha National park gate. We will start our climb here! It is common <b>to see wildlife</b> on this leg of the trek, such as giraffes and zebras. We will pass by the “little Serengeti” plain.</p> <p>Lunch boxes will be enjoyed at picnic sites along the way, and hot dinner and overnight will be at Miriakamba Hut.</p>	Miriakamba Hut.
2	Saddle Hut 3500 m & Summit 4566m.	<p>In the morning we will depart for trek to Miriakamba, and we will trek to Saddle Hut. <b>This is a steep challenge</b> through dense forest and a nice view point at the halfway point. It is common to spot monkeys and indigenous flowers and birds.</p> <p><b>Hot lunch is served at Saddle Hut camp.</b> After a rest of 2h, your guide will take you on an <b>acclimatization trek to Little Meru.</b></p> <p>Hot dinner and overnight at the camp. We will go to bed early for a short sleep before our summit!</p> <p><b>Around 2 am</b> your guide will lead you on the summit trail. We will reach <b>the summit at sunrise</b>, where there are spectacular views of Arusha, Mt. Kilimanjaro, ash cone, and the seven lakes of Arusha National Park</p>	Saddle Hut.
3	Momela Gate 1500m & Marangu	<p>After enjoying breakfast, <b>we will follow a trail</b> that takes us to the real dense forest of Mt. Meru. We like to see waterbuck, red daika, and primates, such as white and blue colobus monkeys. <b>Elephant sighting</b> is possible!</p> <p>We will continue to descend, reaching the gate late afternoon.</p> <p>We will drop you off at <b>Mai Kilimanjaro Homestay for dinner</b> or at the airport for your next destination.</p>	<a href="#">Mai Kilimanjaro Home Stay</a>
