

## Marangu Village 1 day trip

1	<b>Marangu Village</b> <b>1820m</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>“Marangu mean´s “much water”, Marangu is Chagga land”.</b></p> <p>In the morning, we will can go to <b>viewpoint</b> with the <b>rising sun</b> on our right before our morning coffee or breakfast. Also, we will visit Marangu Gate at 1900m. This is the starting point for the Marangu climbing route. The mood is catching and we may have to take one more cup of coffee before you take off up the mountain!</p> <p><b><u>Chagga Tribe</u></b></p> <p>Our Marangu day trip has it all: <b>culture, cuisine, caves and plenty of lively conversation</b>. You’ll even take a dip in a waterfall or two, so bring your energy. You’ll explore the culture and terrifying <b>history</b> of the Chagga Tribe (they built those caves for a reason) and you’ll take a short but delightful hike in the lush green landscape to a sparkling waterfall but, don’t worry, you won’t run out of energy because you’ll visit our Chagga man to experience and test our local brew made from Banana, fingers millet and quinine plant.</p> <p><b><u>Coffee Farm</u></b></p> <p><b>Marangu is coffee country</b> and the beans are locally grown, blended and roasted. We’ll stop at a bijou coffee farm, where <b>you’ll learn how the locals grow, harvest and process their coffee beans that grow</b> in this perfect climate. You’ll even get the chance to try your hand at roasting and preparing your own cup of lovely, fresh coffee. Don't forget the “Chagga house” is at the Site.</p> <p><b><u>Ndoro Waterfall</u></b></p> <p>Next, we’ll depart for the Ndoro Waterfalls for some post-prandial fresh air. The <b>thirty-minute hike</b> to the base of the waterfall will lead us through lush <b>green forest</b> and a steep climb down to the rocks. Enjoy the sparkling waters tumbling down the falls from the rock side or take a refreshing dip in the pool itself.</p> <p><b><u>Chagga Ancient Cave</u></b></p> <p>All this culture is probably giving you an appetite, so our next stop is for a tasty and traditionally Chagga lunch at our favorite little restaurant, or go back to our house for the Hot Lunch.</p>	<a href="#"><u>Mai Kilimanjaro Home Stay</u></a>
